Forsyth Barr Commentary

SUM scored well across the C, S, and G categories, scoring A-, B+ and A respectively. It has a commitment to reducing net emissions, being Toitū Net Carbon Zero certified and having a science-aligned target in place. The Company is also a member of the New Zealand Green Building Council, providing staff with access to technical knowledge on best environmental building practices. It is the E category where SUM'S lack of water consumption and biodiversity commitments affect its performance the most. However, this is offset by a strong showing in the Company's commitment to greener builds by having one of its largest builds featuring a 6 star home rating, and its villa builds currently exceeding building code requirements. We note that there are two key S metrics that we are watching closely in this sector — the affordability of care beds and employee turnover.
